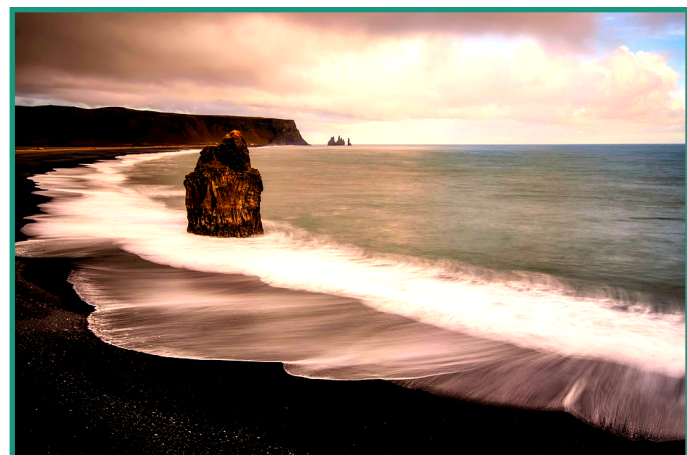

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ITINERARY:

Day 1: DEPART USA - Depart Boston on your overnight flight to Reykjavík, Iceland!

Day 2: WELCOME TO REYKJAVIK - Transfer to your hotel for an early check-in and breakfast. This afternoon head out for a Reykjavík city tour. See the old town center, the Parliament, the Cathedral, the harbor, the Pearl, the National Museum, Höfði house, and more. You will also get to visit the Aurora Museum to learn more about the Northern Lights. The evening is at your leisure. **(B)**

Day 3: DAY AT LEISURE - Today is a free day for you to explore the world's northernmost capital. See and experience its colorful buildings, quirky, creative people and eye-popping design. Tonight, drive out to the countryside for your first attempt at seeing the dancing lights of the aurora. If the night is clear and everything aligns for a viewing, be prepared for a memory of a lifetime. **(B)**

Day 4: SOUTH SHORE - Traverse the fertile farmlands of South-Iceland heading towards the ice capped volcano, Eyjafjallajökull. Enjoy a quick stop at the Lava Center to deepen your understanding of Iceland's complex geology. You will also see the Seljalandsfoss and Skógafoss waterfalls tumbling over high rock escarpments, a row of towering glaciers and the Reynisdrangar rock pillars decorating the black beach. After a memorable day, reach the town of Selfoss. Enjoy dinner at the hotel then join your guide and fellow travelers on an evening walk for a second attempt to see the spectacular swirling Northern Lights. **(B, D)**

Day 5: SOUTHWEST ICELAND - This is a full-day of touring the Southwest of Iceland. Sights include the best-known attractions Iceland has to offer: Gullfoss, one of the most impressive waterfalls in Europe with thousands of tons of icy water thundering majestically into a deep canyon, The Geysir Area, with numerous hot springs, fumaroles and geysers, including the 30-meter spouting world known Strokkur to name a few. Included is a visit and lunch at Friðheimar tomato greenhouse where tomatoes are cultivated year-round using the latest technology, in an environmentally-friendly way. You will also see a demonstration of the famed five gaits of the Icelandic horse. After the show, feel free to chat with the horse's riders, pet the animals and take pictures in the stable. **(B, L)**



Day 6: BLUE LAGOON - DEPART ICELAND - There is one more "must do" experience in beautiful Iceland before heading home. The famous Blue Lagoon. You will have time this morning to swim in pleasantly warm mineral-rich geothermal water located in the middle of a black lava field. The high natural levels of silica and minerals give the Lagoon its rich blue color. Facilities here include modern changing rooms and showers, an indoor geothermal pool, a winter garden, restaurants and other services. A swim in the Blue Lagoon is absolutely invigorating and the stop here will be for approximately three hours. Continue from here to Keflavík International Airport for your flight home. **(B)**
